


## Neilston Primary School



1875.

Sep. 3<sup>d</sup> Intimated to Half-timers that after Monday the 13<sup>th</sup> written excuses must be produced by them for absence.

" 10<sup>th</sup> By personal examination of all the junior classes found that increased attention must be paid to the Spelling of the pupils in Standard II.

" 17<sup>th</sup> Head master absent from duties

" 23<sup>rd</sup> Found that the regulation requiring written excuses from the Half-timers is raising their attendance very considerably.

" 30<sup>th</sup> General work progressing satisfactorily.

Oct. 1<sup>st</sup> Had to write to Crofthead Mill about a half-timer who delayed the production of an excuse for absence.

<b>Name of creator</b>	Neilston Primary School
<b>Administrative/ biographical history</b>	The school was established shortly after the passing of the Education (Scotland) Act 1872, passing to the control of the County of Renfrew, then Strathclyde Region and latterly to East Renfrewshire Council.
<b>Archival history</b>	The archives were held at the school until the building's redevelopment in December 2023
<b>Immediate source of acquisition</b>	Neilston Primary School
<b>Scope and content</b>	The records comprise log books, admission registers, inspection, etc., reports and the papers of the papers of the Colonel Mure of Caldwell Memorial Bursery
<b>Appraisal, destruction and scheduling information</b>	All records transferred have been retained. Other material, including numerous photographs, were not transferred
<b>Accruals</b>	none expected
<b>System of arrangement</b>	The records have been arranged as follows: 1: Log Books of the school and related bodies 2: Admission Registers 3: Inspection Certificates 4: Colonel Mure Memorial Bursery records
<b>Conditions governing access</b>	Some records are closed for defined periods to protect the personal data of individuals as per the guidelines agreed by the Archivists of Scottish Local Authorities Working Group. Individuals, however, may request to view their own personal records.
