ROADS REVENUE WORKS PROGRAMME 2018/19

PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. The purpose of this report is to seek approval for the Roads Revenue Works Programme for 2018/19.

RECOMMENDATIONS

2. It is recommended that the Cabinet approves the Roads Revenue Works Programme of £3,955,300 for 2018/19 as set out in Appendix A.

BACKGROUND

- 3. The Roads Revenue Works Programme covers routine maintenance, winter maintenance, and carriageway and footway resurfacing and patching.
- 4. The total Revenue Budget available for the Revenue Works Programme is £3,955,300.
- 5. Prioritisation of the proposed resurfacing schemes has taken the following factors into consideration:
 - The structural condition of the road or footway.
 - The usage of the road or footway.
 - Cost of maintenance for the previous three years.
 - Number of complaints received regarding the road/footway.
 - Geographical spread.
- 6. The winter maintenance budget for 2018/19 has been maintained at £900,000. The policy and practice for winter maintenance is currently being reviewed and will be the subject of a separate report to cabinet in the spring of 2018.

7. It is proposed that the revenue expenditure will be allocated as follows:

8. The detailed Revenue Works Programme is set out in Appendix A.

FINANCE AND EFFICIENCY

- 9. The extent of the resurfacing work proposed may require the supplementing of our internal Road Contracting Unit resources by external contractors.
- 10. Benchmarking with private contractors will continue to be carried out to ensure that the Roads Contracting Unit are providing value for money.

CONSULTATION

11. The previous year a consultation process was undertaken as part of a participatory budget exercise. In addition regular feedback from members of the public and elected members feed into the Roads Revenue Works Programme.

PARTNERSHIP WORKING

12. The Roads Service continues to liaise with partner organisations such as utility providers when undertaking notifiable road work projects.

IMPLICATIONS OF THE PROPOSALS

13. The 2018/19 Revenue Works programme details the planned expenditure for Routine Maintenance, Winter Maintenance and Structural maintenance of the road networks. As detailed above it may be necessary to engage external contractors to carry out some of the works in addition to the Council's Road Contracting Unit. There are no further implications in terms of property, legal, IT, equalities and sustainability.

CONCLUSIONS

14. The 2018/19 Revenue Works programme is designed to provide the best available spend within the available resources.

RECOMMENDATIONS

15. It is recommended that the Cabinet approves the Roads Revenue Works Programme of £3,955,300 for 2018/19 as set out in Appendix A.

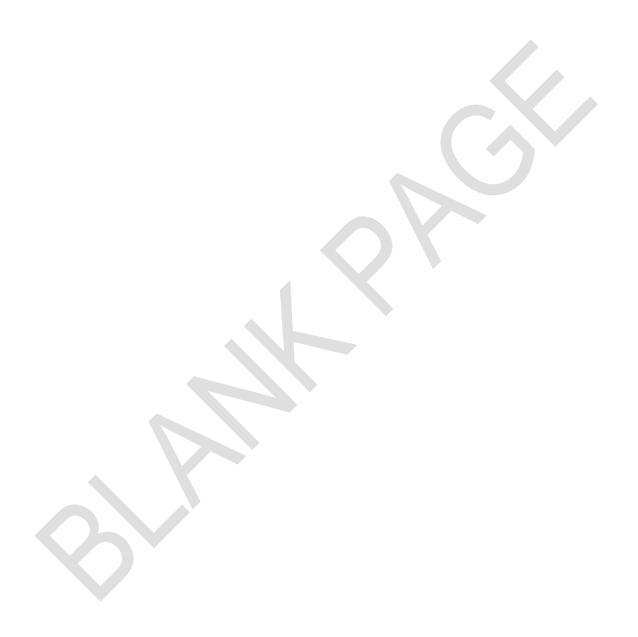
