Resolution to Exclude Press and Public

PRIVATE HIRE CAR DRIVER'S LICENCE - REQUEST FOR SUSPENSION

1324. The committee considered a report by the Chief Officer (Legal & Procurement) relative to a request from the Chief Constable that a private hire car driver's licence be suspended on the grounds that the licensee was no longer a fit and proper person to be the holder of a licence by virtue of having been reported to the Procurator Fiscal in relation to a number of serious offences. The licensee was not present. Inspector Dickson, representing the Chief Constable who had made the request for suspension, was present.

Having fully discussed the contents of the report, the committee agreed to suspend the licence with immediate effect in terms of Paragraph 12 of Schedule 1 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 on the grounds that the carrying on of the activity to which the licence related was likely to cause a serious threat to public safety.
