

Name of creator	Capelrig Estate
Administrative/ biographical history	Capelrig estate comprised the Georgian Capelrig House, Huntersfield, Craigend, Townfoot, Broomfield and Shieldhill, all in the parish of Mearns. It is described as "Temple Lands", and is also written "Caplerig". In the period covered by these papers, the Estate (or parts thereof) was held by: George and Mary Brown (to 1811), William Burridge Cabbell, Robert Brown, et al. (1811 to) Mary Brown, Mrs Barclay Brown, et al., 1870 James Barclay Murdoch (x1886 - 1892x) Peter Maxwell Murdoch, et al. (to 1907) Thomas Clement (1907 to) Jack MacTaggart (1928 to)
Archival history	The papers were acquired by Renfrewshire Council, apparently at auction from Lyon & Turnbull of London, in 2005. They were transferred from Renfrewshire to ERC's libraries in 2012.
Immediate source of acquisition	The papers were transferred to ERC archives as part of accession 2013/04 in Aug 2013.
Scope and content	The papers comprise title deeds (1811 - 1915); rentals, valuations & statements of revenue (1914 - 1936); particulars of sale & associated papers (1928 - 1930).
Appraisal, destruction and scheduling information	All records transferred to the archives have been retained.
Accruals	No further accruals are expected.
System of arrangement	The papers have been arranged as follows: 1. title deeds 2. rentals, valuations, etc. 3. sale papers
Conditions governing access	There are no restrictions on access.
