Police Report

Parking Hazard

A resident emailed the community council about a parking issue on Braiholm Road/Gowanlea Drive.

Provost Monatgue informed the community council that residents should take a photograph of this and related issues and email to ERC. The issue will be then logged, given a number and dealt with by the appropriate department.

Disability Access Giffnock

Provost Montague and Marion Millar are to arrange a walk about Giffnock to observe issues regarding disability issues which will then lead to a mobility audit of the area.

Huntly Park- Cats eyes

Provost Montague informed the community council that she had been in contact with Kirsty and 1/3 of the cats eyes are not working. These fall under the remit of Sustrans to replace.

The issue of the crumbling wall should be referred to the parks department to be resolved.

AOB

- Meetings- It was agreed that GCC should host 10 meeting per year. Meeting in July and December will not be held.
- 20mph zones. ERC have issued plans to have 20mph zones in East Refrewshire and to hold a consultation on line. GCC find that this is not an inclusive approach and will write to the council to raise this and the other concerns they have on the proposal.
- Andrew raised a point on fundraising for community councils and noted that having the community councils work together on applications could be a way forward.
- Marion raised the topic of potential funding for 'Boris Bikes' as something to aim for.
